

Summer Activities 2021

21st June to 15th September

Hike to Trollsjön (Rissajaure)

The tour begins through mountain birch forest, the path soon takes us up past the tree line and further up into Kärkevagge which means the Stone valley in Sami. The valley is filled with boulders of various sizes some large as multi-storey houses, which gave the name of the valley. At the end of Kärkevagge lies Trollsjön (Troll lake). The lake is incredibly clear and has a depth of 36m and in good conditions you can see all the way down to the bottom. Once at the lake, it is time for lunch and for those who dare a refreshing dip in the clear but ice cold water. The lake's Sami name is Rissajaure which means “The lake that sparkles like fire”.

During the hike your guide will tell you about the history of the area and about the plants and wildlife that you can find in the mountains.

The tours start at 09:00. The duration is approximately 7 hours.

Walking distance: 12 km. Elevation difference: +/- 400 m.

Recommended minimum age: 12 years.

Included: Guide, transfers from/to your accommodation in Abisko or Björkliden and safety equipment.


Bring: Rain clothes, warm sweater, hat, something to drink and lunch pack.

Caving Adventure

One of Sweden's longest cave systems is "hidden" near Abisko. After packing our car with caving equipment and driving westwards for a few kilometers we hike up the mountainside to the entrance of a cave called "Kåppashåla". Before our descent underground we put on overalls, helmets and headlamps and then the guide leads you down through a labyrinth of narrow passageways and fabulous formations created by water flowing for thousands of years.

Above ground again, we walk along Kåppasjåkka River where we can also pause to see waterfalls and giants' kettles.

Cave guide, transport, caving equipment (helmet, overalls, lamp and boots)

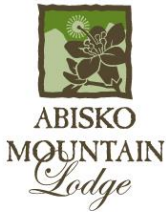

Midnight sun hike to the top of mount Nuolja

After a short walk, your midnight sun experience begins in a chair-lift, gliding slowly and quietly upwards with mountain scenery as your panorama. Eventually the chairlift reaches STF Aurora Sky Station and from there, at 900 meters elevation, you will start the 2 km hike to the summit that sits at 1164 meters elevation. Along the way we do multiple stops where you get time to enjoy the view and listen to the guide that tells us about the history of our surroundings, from ice age to northern light hotspot. At the summit we celebrate the accomplishment with a well-deserved drink and some local snacks, and if the weather allows, we get to enjoy all this in the beautiful glow of the midnight sun. Soon after midnight we start the hike back down to the chairlift that will take you down you Abisko Turiststation.

Guided hike, return ticket for chair-lift, beverage and snacks on the top of Mount Nuolja.

Length: 4km (about 2,5 hrs hiking)

Other requirements: No special skills required
